

THE NATIONAL CORONAVIRUS LOCKDOWN

News Update from the Astronomy Group

The lock-down will have a very major impact on anyone wishing to take in the majesty of the night sky, however there is still some interesting things and events to view if you have a window, balcony or patio. Last night, April 3rd Members of the Astronomy were informed that the brilliant planet Venus, the brightest object in the evening sky except for the Moon, would be positioned within the Pleiades Cluster, commonly known as The Seven Sisters. Binoculars or a small telescope were useful to view it clearly but keen-eyed people may have noticed the scene. Venus will continue to be a brilliant evening sky object for some time to come. There is to be a "Super Moon" on April 8th however this is a little misleading, the term is used to denote when the Full Moon is closer to us than normally and so appears slightly larger. The Moon's orbit is very complex and the distance between the Earth and the Moon vary constantly from 356, 500 km to 406,700 km.



The dawn sky has the planets Mars, Jupiter and Saturn visible 1 hour before dawn and these are bright and easy to see. Mars you will notice has a reddish colouring which to the ancients made it appear rather aggressive and of course it was the Roman God of War!

There has been much excitement about Comet ATLAS, which could become a bright and impressive visitor to the night sky in May. Comet

ATLAS was discovered by the Asteroid Terrestial-Impact Last Alert System based in Hawaii. The system is used to detect solar system objects which may possibly impact Earth. Comets are however very fickle and as they come closer to the Sun, from deep-space they brighten increasingly due to ices and dust particles being released, producing impressive Comas and tails, however many "fizzle out" before closest approach and are only observed by users of relatively large telescope.



Predictions for this comet are that it is to be very impressive, it is quite a large object and it is now brightening progressively. Its orbit has been calculated and it has travelled inwards from an incredible 662 AU (that is 662 times the Earth Sun Distance) taking 4,800 years approximately to reach the Sun. As it has likely not lost much of its volatile material Astronomers are expecting a fine display.

The Lyrids Meteor shower will be visible on April 22nd and of course this event requires the observer to be viewing in the early morning hours. No special equipment or knowledge is required just patiently view the sky in the general SE direction and look out for the bright "shooting stars". Sometimes observers see more than 100 in an hour, however sometimes this figure is far less. If you have any questions about astronomy please do contact <u>james.ince1@tiscali.co.uk</u>
